## 2018 TYFSA Venom Softball Information

TYFSA is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization dedicated to promoting excellence in girls' fastpitch softball. We focus on providing girls living in the Triton School District and other nearby communities the opportunity to play competitively while developing the athletic skills to move to the next level. Our goal is to teach the fundamentals of fastpitch softball in a healthy, safe and positive environment while reinforcing the values of teamwork and sportsmanship. We play our home games at North Park in Dodge Center and at West Concord Community Field.

\$125 – Registration Fee

\$50 – Jersey Fee (one jersey included for new players)

We also require a check for \$150 to cover the 15 hours of volunteer time that is required per player. If the 15 hours are completed, then the check is returned. 4 hours of this time must be completed at our home tournament

12u plays double headers on Tuesday and Thursday nights.

14u and 16u teams both play double headers on Monday and Wednesday nights.

The 12u team will participate in our home tournament (June 9<sup>th</sup>) and 1 or 2 out of town tournaments. These are usually no further than 1.5 hours from home, and can be 1 or 2 day tournaments (Saturday and Sunday)

The 14u and 16u teams will also participate in our home tournament, but they will play in 3 or 4 out of town tournaments.

More information on the 18u game nights and tournaments will come later.
